



BAGRATUNI WHITE

Varieties: local Khatoun Kharji, Chenin Blanc

Origin and terroir: Khatoun Kharji, a rare indigenous variety, is from selected vineyards of mountainous Aghavnadzor village, Vayots Dzor region, 1300-1400 m a.s.l.

Chenin Blanc is harvested from Ararat valley vineyards, 1000-1100 m a.s.l.

Yield: 40-50 cwt/ha for Khatun Kharji and 80-90 cwt/ha for Chenin Blanc

Vinification: Each variety was fermented separately in barrels and in stainless steel, after then master blend was organized

Ageing: barrel aged in new and 1-year old Armenian oak barrels up to 6 months

Current vintage: 2019

Alcohol content: 13,0 % by vol.
