

MALAHI RED RESERVE

Varieties: Sev Areni (Areni Noir), Khndoghni, Cot Malbec

Origin and terroir: This wine is a blend of selected vineyards of several terroirs. Indigenous Areni from Aghavnadzor village, volcanic and limestone soil, altitude 1300-1400m a.s.l. Khndoghni from lower Artsakh, altitude 400-S00m a.s.l. Cot Malbec from Ararat valley, volcanic and clay soil, altitude 1000-1100m a.s.l.

Yield: limited to 5-6 t/ha for Areni and Khndoghni, 8-9 t/ha for Cot Malbec.

Vinification: varieties were fermented and aged separately. Prolonged maceration was ensured. Whole blend was completed after barrel ageing.

Barrel ageing: Up to 12 months in barrels and up to 2 years in bottles.

Current vintage: 2019

Alcohol content: 14,0 % by vol.
